OISESA

The school is undergoing its ISASA (Independent Schooling Association of Southern Africa) quality assurance assessment. It is a condition of membership for ISASA schools to undertake the self-study evaluation every six years; an interim progress report is submitted after a period of three years. OISESA is the ISASA-appointed, independent quality assurance body. OISESA - Office of Independent Schools Evaluations Southern Africa.

The evaluation process is guided by a set of globally aligned Standards and Indicators covering the school's mission, governance and leadership, sustainability, culture and climate, communication, the education program, staffing, student wellbeing, safeguarding, health and safety, and facilities and infrastructure.

We will be submitting our self-study report ahead of the on-site school visit. The process allows the school the opportunity to examine areas to celebrate and identify areas for improvement.

OISESA will do an on-site visit on the 14th,15th and 16th of May.
