School Uniform

All students must wear school uniforms daily. Girls are allowed to wear tights, shorts, tracksuit pants, or jeans (no ripped or skinny jeans) with the school golfer and school tracksuit top. Boys can wear shorts, tracksuit pants, or jeans with the school golfer and tracksuit top. There are no specific days for wearing the orange or lime-coloured golfers. If your child is selected for sports events, they will receive a specific sports kit, which is sold in our school office. You will be invoiced for the kit accordingly. Children may wear sports kits to school as part of their uniform. Jewellery is not allowed at school. Please ensure that students' nails are trimmed short to prevent accidental scratching during sports and playtime.

Fees

We remind parents with outstanding fees to please settle their accounts timely. Termly payers should have settled their accounts. Monthly payers, please make payment before the 7th of each month to avoid disruption to learning. Learners with outstanding amounts and no current payment plan or communication with the school will face disruption to learning.
