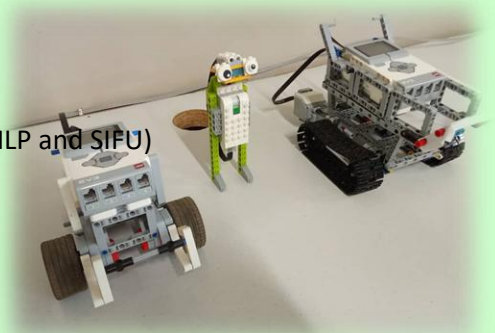
Sports
